Director Marcello became enchanted with the story and wanted to explore as a fairy tale come true. This film was the opener at the 2022 Cannes Film Festival with rave reviews. The story begins with a World War I veteran Raphael (Raphael Thiery), returning to the village in Normandy where he left his wife only to find that she has died, and his infant daughter Juliette is being cared for by a woman with whom his wife worked. Raphael is a very quiet individual whose demeanor is that of an uncultured handyman who works odd jobs to care for Juliette and forges a tender, loving relationship with her. Juliette (Juliette Jouan in her debut film) blossoms into a beautiful, talented young woman who dreams of one day falling in love and being swept away as predicted by a woman dubbed as a witch by the villagers. Do fairy tales come true? Discover the unexpected talents of Raphael and Juliette as the story unfolds with the beautiful music by Lebanese - French composer Gabriel Yared with lyrics adapted from poems by French writer Louise Michel.

2022 – CHINA IN MANDARIN WITH ENGLISH SUBTITLES

Written and directed by Li Ruijun filmed in Gaotai County in the Gansu province of China a rural impoverished farming area where the inhabitants still eke out a living by working the land as they did in ancient times. The setting is a village where Youtie (Renlin Wu) is meeting Guiying (Hai-Qing) in a gathering of relatives. They are two unmarried quiet, unassuming, middle-aged individuals whose respective families have arranged their marriage. What follows is a thought-provoking storyline that delves into the hardships these individuals face as they build their life together with nothing except for Youtie's hardworking ingenuity. An evocative narrative on a society that appears to be left behind. When this film was released in China it became a hit and was quickly withdrawn by the authorities perhaps because it revealed too much. Ultimately, this film is a tender love story. The film portrays John (James Norton), a 35-year-old window cleaner who has dedicated his life to bringing up his 4-year-old son, Michael, (Daniel Lamont) after the child's mother left them soon after giving birth. When John is given only a few months left to live, he attempts to find a new, perfect family for Michael, determined to shield him from the terrible reality of the situation. Although initially certain of what he is looking for in the perfect family, John gradually abandons his early convictions, overwhelmed by doubts on the decision. As John struggles to find the right answer to his impossible task, he comes to accept the help of a young social worker, Shona (Carol Moore), opening himself to solutions he would never have considered.
